

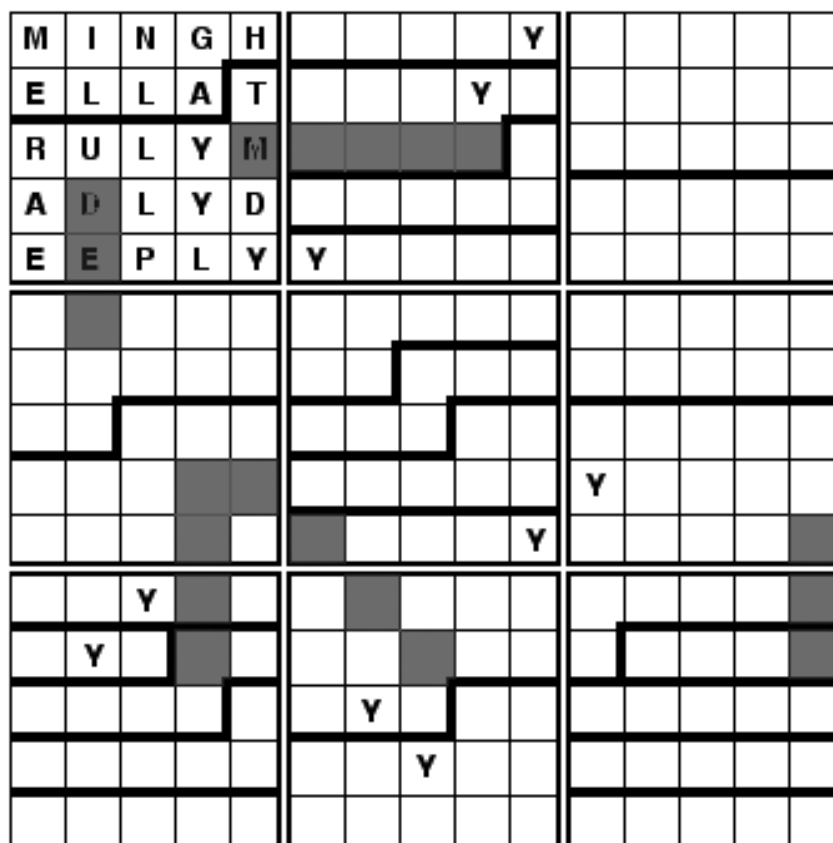


# The surefish Pub Quiz Puzzle March 2008

## How to Play

Each area separated with a thick line contains a particular answer (reading left to right), which may contain more than one word.
