



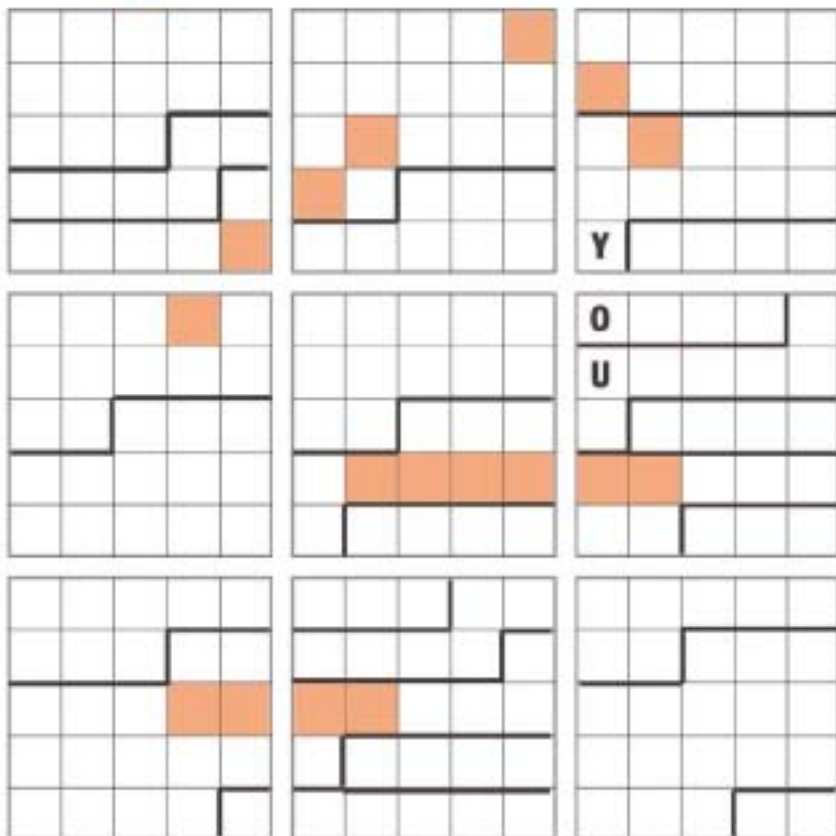
The surefish Pub Quiz Puzzle May 2008

How to Play
