### How to Play

The Trivioku puzzle combines the logical challenge of a sudoku puzzle with the fun of a general knowledge quiz!

Each Trivioku leads to a word or phrase as the final answer. First solve the grid just like any normal sudoku – each number from 1-9 appears only once in each 3x3 square, each horizontal line and each vertical line.

Then answer the general knowledge questions below. If you replace the numbers along the middle line of the sudoku grid with the first letter of each corresponding quiz answer, a word or phrase will be revealed. (Only nine different letters are used in the entire puzzle.)
