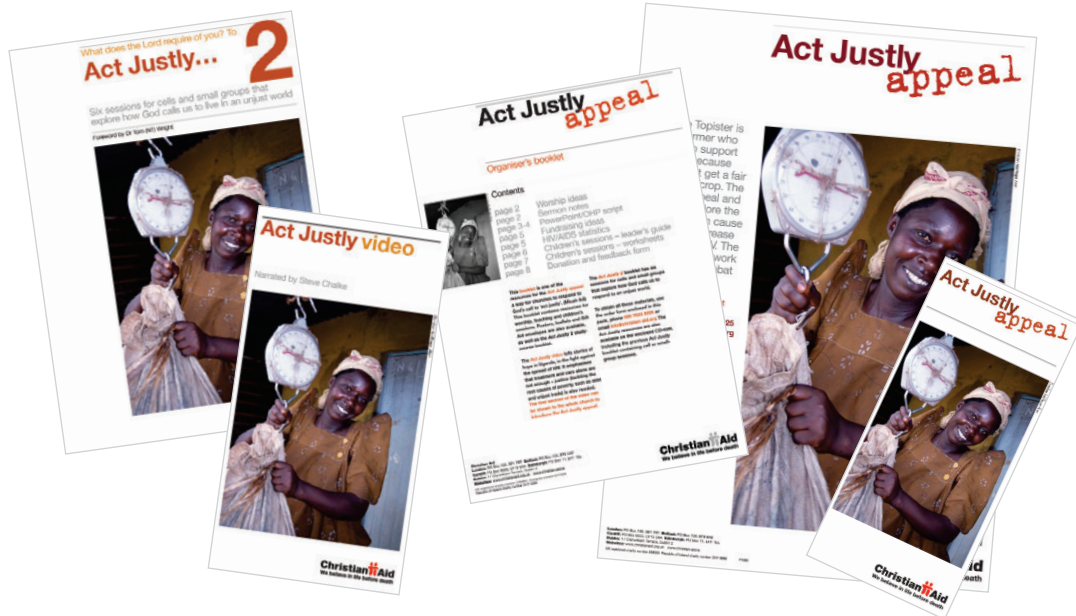

For coffee farmers such as Newumbe Topister (front cover) in Uganda, it is becoming increasingly hard to earn a living. 'I sell the coffee I grow to middle men,' she says. 'The price I get does not meet my requirements, so I cannot look after my children properly.' She plans to join a nearby fair-trade coffee-growing cooperative, which will pay her a fair price for her crop.

The rules that govern world trade are biased against poor countries. Despite the promises of rich governments, more than US\$250 billion of debts owed by poor countries to rich countries still haven't been cancelled. Of the people living with HIV worldwide, 95 per cent are in poor countries. The world is not fair.

But as Christians we are called to challenge this. God did not intend the world to be this way. We take our inspiration from the words of the prophet Micah:

What does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God. (Micah 6:8)



Act Justly 2, a sequel to the extremely popular *Act Justly* booklet, is a second set of six sessions for cells and small groups that explore how God calls us to live in an unjust world.

The **Act Justly video**, narrated by Steve Chalke, tells the story of a church leaders' visit to Uganda, and accompanies the appeal and the sessions of the *Act Justly 2* booklet.

The **Act Justly appeal** is a way for the whole church to respond to God's call, through teaching, prayer and giving.
